- AY23 IMS Badge Ceremony 8 June at 9:00. Arrive 8:15-8:45 and be seated by 8:45. Ceremony will start promptly at 9:00.
- ISMD will provide shuttle service from 8:00-9:30. Pickup from the old Bell Hall Parking lot near/at the inside parking lot corner of Sherman and Reynolds Ave and drop off near the circle of Lewis and Clark.
- AY23 IMS Graduation 9 June at 9:00 (IMSD advises sponsors NOT attend)
- Both events are in-person sponsors will be seated in the auditorium for the Badge Ceremony unless arriving late, then will be seated in the overflow area

- Flexibility is key to sponsorship
  - Guidelines and rules developed early may change as conditions warrant
- Sponsors are encouraged to meet IMS at the airport
- IMS will report on 19 June
- In-person Icebreakers with sponsors are planned for 10-13 July (attend on the night you're invited)



- Physical interaction and traditional IMSD sponsored events are planned, but may change if conditions warrant otherwise
- If conditions permit focus on "Community Integration" period 19 June – 06 August. This is when the IMS will most need your help getting settled and acclimated to life in the United States.
- Flag Ceremony is 07 Aug at Lewis & Clark
- "Pace" of the course (starting 07 Aug) will again be even more intense than usual. Most class days between August and the Winter Break will be at least 6 hours in duration.



### How to obtain your LAC Cards

- Link to the application: http://www.gkcptp.org/fortaccess.htm Instructions are on the GKCPTP website. A few reminders:
  - Complete only the top two (2) sections of the form labeled (completed by applicant), the Application Information and Criminal History
  - Do NOT complete the sections labeled (completed by sponsor)
  - Do NOT sign the form; the signature is done at time of pickup
  - Return completed form to Pat Burnett or Sharon Valasek
- Pat or Sharon will submit the LAC app to IMSD for processing
- Processing time varies depending on IMSD availability, accuracy of information, accuracy of processing and Visitors Control Center (VCC) factors



- How to pick up your approved LAC ID
  - Once notified by Pat or Sharon that the LAC pass is approved, applicant has 30 days from date of VCC approval to pick up from the VCC
  - Before driving to Leavenworth, it is highly recommended the applicant call the VCC before driving there to ensure:
    - VCC has your approved application (it's possible sponsors will be unable to get confirmation of approved application)
    - VCC's systems are functioning
  - Pick up LAC pass promptly; VCC allows three (3) applications
  - Each individual picks up their own pass (e.g., cannot pick up for spouse)



#### LAC ID Reminders

- All passes expire in February in compliance with IMSD policy
- A new LAC Pass is required annually, thus this process repeats annually
- Sponsors submit apps Jan 1-31 each year, including anyone who submitted later than the January cutoff (e.g., new sponsors)



- GKCPTP has a distinctive focus on military officer sponsorship
